Cost: \$7 in council, \$12 out of council

What to bring: tent, sleeping bag, sleeping pad, mess kit, camp chair, water bottle (filled), personal clothes, toiletries, toilet paper, hand sanitizer, flashlight, note book and pen, Class "A" and "B" uniforms, and MASKS which must be worn.

Due to health concerns it will be very important that everyone has their own eating utensils and coffee cup (coffee will be provided). Sanitation resources will be available to clean your utensils.

You will be required to pre-make and freeze a foil meal for your lunch, to be cooked at camp on the fire, See the video links on the registration page for instructions. Bring personal snacks for Friday evening and during the day on Saturday. Breakfast will be provided
