Skill instruction for teaching Tenderfoot through First Class ranks. Price includes all meals except Friday evening meal. Please plan to arrive and check-in between 5:30 -6:00 pm Friday night. Use the Boy Scout handbook and the list below for things you need to bring. You will be camping outdoors in tents.

Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills: Gather new skills based on outdoor training found in the Boy Scout handbook. The purpose is to build confidence and competence for outdoor camping. This is required for all Scoutmasters, Assistant Scoutmasters, and Venture Crew coaches. To be fully trained as a SM or ASM you need Scoutmaster Specifics, IOLS and Hazardous weather training.

What to bring:

Tent, Sleeping bag, Sleeping pad, Scout handbook, Mess kit, Water bottle filled, Personal clothes, Toiletries, Flashlight, Compass, Note book and pen, “Class A and B “, Lantern for tent area if you wish.

Due to health concerns it will be very important that everyone has their own eating utensils and coffee cup, (coffee will be provided). Sanitation resources will be available to clean your utensils. You will also need to bring a face mask to wear during the weekend, toilet paper had hand personal hand sanitizer.
